1. Siamese cats are named for the Asian country formerly called Siam. What name is used for Siam today?
2. Which breed of large dogs is named for residents of Denmark?
3. Which breed of very small dogs is named for a desert in northern México?
4. Manx cats have no tails. They come from the Isle of Man, in the Celtic Sea, between England and this country.
5. Coon cats have very long fur and are named for the USA state bordered by New Brunswick and Québec. Name the state.
6. Name one of the two breeds of large dogs named after the same Canadian province.
7. Persian cats are long-furred and like to purr. What name is used for Persia today?
8. This breed of large dogs, now commonly used as guard dogs and for police work, was first bred to help herd sheep in the hills along the Rhine River. Name the breed.
9. Somali cats, a newly popular breed, have long orange-brown fur and gold eyes. On what continent is the country of Somalia?
10. If you wanted to buy an Irish Wolfhound or an Irish Setter in the capital of Ireland, what city should you go to?
