6. Name the province that is the only one with coastlines along both Hudson Bay and the Gulf of St. Lawrence.
7. Name the territory that is Canada's newest and largest.
8. The largest cities in this province are Saint John and Moncton. Name the province.
9. Name the prairie province that contains Grasslands and Prince Albert National Parks.
10. The Strait of Belle Isle divides this province into two large parts. Name the province.
