6. What is the name given to the line with a latitude of zero degrees that divides the earth into two equal halves?
7. What is the letter and name of the largest country in South America?
8. This North American country is a partner with Canada and the United States in the North American Free Trade Agreement or NAFTA. What is the letter and name of this country?
9. This country is largely made up of one of the world's great deserts, the Gobi desert. Give the letter and name of this country.
10. Give the name and letter of the country that is the world's largest producer of gold.
