4. This black-and-white animal lives in China and only eats bamboo.
5. This black-and-white bird, which cannot fly but swims well, lives in the waters around Antarctica.
6. This black-and-white bird, which also cannot fly but runs well, lives in Africa.
7. This bird has white feathers on its head, and is used as a symbol by the United States of America.
8. This black-and-white whale lives in both the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans, and eats fish and seals.
9. What name is given to the most dangerous of the large sharks, found in both the Atlantic and Pacific Ocean?
10. Tasmanian Devils are black-and-white marsupials. Which country is Tasmania a part of?
