This round of ten questions is about geographical symbols on Canadian provincial and territorial flags.

1. Name the province or territory whose flag shows the sun setting into the Pacific Ocean.
2. Four symbols, each representing a flower, are found on the flag of Québec. What are these symbols called?
3. A large orange prairie lily appears on the green and yellow flag of this province. Name the province.
4. This large mammal shown on the flag of Manitoba was saved from extinction in the 1880's. What is the name of this mammal?
5. Name the province or territory whose flag shows an Inukshuk.
6. This small province's flag shows three small saplings protected by a great oak tree. Name the province.
7. Name the province whose flag shows golden wheat, bright blue sky, and mountains.
8. Name the province whose flag shows three maple leaves joined together at the base.
9. This territory's flag shows the river, which the territory is named after, flowing between two mountains.
10. Name the province whose flag shows a ship sailing on the ocean.
