7. Name one of the two islands, owned by France, located near the Burin Peninsula of Newfoundland.
8. Located east of the African continent, this is the largest island in the Indian Ocean. Name the island.
9. This island, the largest in South America, is shared by Argentina and Chile. Name the island.
10. This island in the USA contains the volcanoes Kilauea, Mauna Kea and Mauna Loa. Name the island.
