



## Map of Europe

*In this round of ten questions, students must name the European country and then locate it by letter on the map provided. The answers include only those countries marked by letters "A" through "L". Each question in this round is worth two points.*

1. Name and locate the country which contains the cities of Lisbon and Porto.
2. Name and locate the country which borders the Black Sea, and from which many people emigrated to western Canada between 1890 and 1910.
3. Name and locate the country that was reunited when a wall was destroyed in 1989.
4. Name and locate the Scandinavian country known for its blue-and-yellow flag, its long winters and its hockey teams.
5. Name and locate the country whose capital contains the Eiffel Tower, the Louvre and the Arc de Triomphe.
6. Name and locate the country where Beethoven and Mozart composed music while looking at the Danube River in Vienna.
7. Name and locate the country that is the most northern of the three Baltic Republics, and has Tallinn as its capital.
8. Name and locate the country which lies between the Adriatic and Tyrrhenian Seas, where many people from Montréal and Toronto have family connections.
9. Name and locate the country which contains the cities of Kraków and Gdansk.
10. The language of this country is currently spoken in South and North America by more people than any other language. Name and locate the country.
