3. Terra Nova National Park is located in which Atlantic province?
4. Auyuittuq, the 'land that never melts', is located in which territory?
5. La Mauricie National Park, along the Saint-Maurice River, is located north of which city midway between Montréal and Québec?
6. Pukaskwa, Ontario's largest National Park, is located on the shore of Ontario's largest lake. Name the lake.
7. Kouchibouguac was established to conserve coastal sand dunes and salt marshes along the Gulf of St. Lawrence in this province. Name the province.
8. The Cabot Trail passes through this National Park in Nova Scotia. What is the name of this National Park?
9. Riding Mountain National Park is located in this province. Name the province.
10. The most southerly of Alberta's National Parks is adjacent to Glacier National Park in the USA. Name the National Park.
